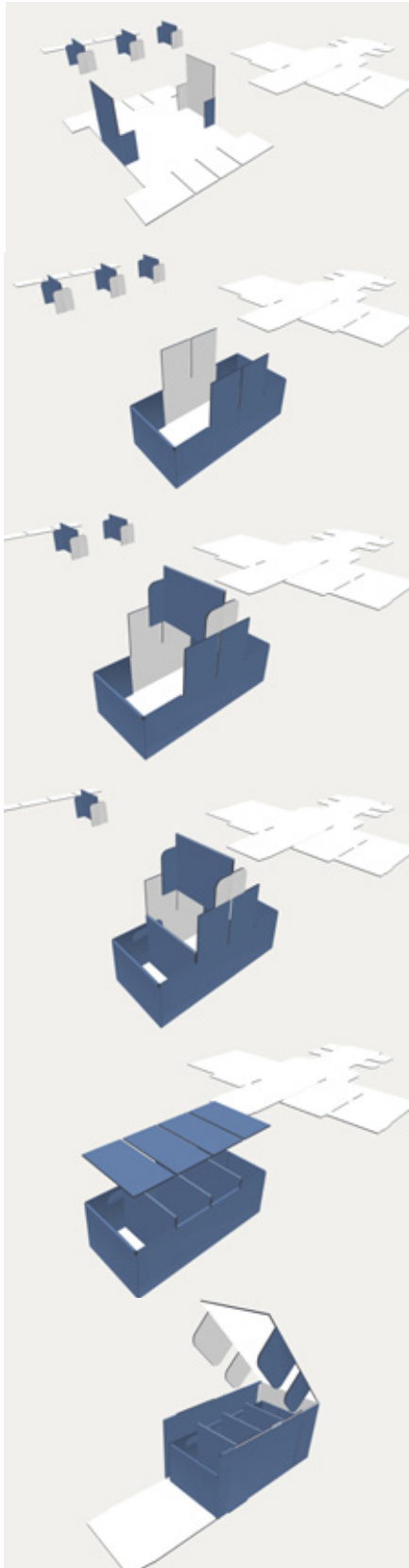


Archival boxes – KS 15

Folding instructions



1. The precut pattern of your box cutting should be placed on the table with the natural white coloured side facing towards you.
2. The KS 15 box comprises of a traditional KS 7 box (corpus) and a KS 12 box (interior element). In order to fold the KS 7 box, please refer to the folding instructions of the KS 7 box. Unlike our standard KS 12 model, this version of the KS 12 box has three additional partitions.
3. Please follow the instructions mentioned below while inserting the partitions: Set up the shorter sides of the box right-angled. Fold the segments of the longer sides of the box over the flaps of the shorter side. The flaps of the segments should now face outwards. The shorter segments of the box are now folded over the flaps of the side segments.
4. Insert the two exterior partitions into the box. As a result, the flaps are folded in the space between the already folded side segments.
5. Thereafter insert the middle partition and fold the remaining walls of the side segments.
6. Finally you may insert the base reinforcement into the box.
