Museum paper – coloured varieties



Specifications:

Coloured, ageing-resistant museum paper with an alkaline buffer offering maximum permanency. Suitable as photocopy paper and as interleaving sheets in folders, spans, files and binders.

Sizes ex-stock:

82 x 102 cm, 102 x 142 cm, 81 x 101 cm, 101 x 141 cm, 107 x 86 cm, 103 x 143 cm

Material characteristics:

- 100% bleached cellulose
- without the usage of recycling fibres
- free of wooden fibres
- Kappa level 1 – 2 = lignin-free
- pH 7.5 - 10.0 = acid-free (in accordance with ISO 6588-1:2020)
- alkaline buffer > 3% natural calcium carbonate (GCC)
- sizing: neutral/synthetic (without alum additive)
